We are seeking a highly organized and mission-driven Supply Chain Manager to lead our supply chain operations, ensuring the smooth and ethical flow of both perishable and non-perishable food items from donation or purchase to distribution. The ideal candidate will play a critical role in maintaining food safety standards, minimizing waste, and maximizing the impact of our resources.

This role requires strategic thinking, operational excellence, and a strong passion for community service.

Key Responsibilities:

- Oversee end-to-end supply chain activities including procurement, inventory control, storage, and distribution
- Implement First In, First Out (FIFO) inventory methods to reduce waste and manage expiry-sensitive products
- Ensure proper handling and storage of food—especially perishables—in compliance with food safety regulations
- Forecast demand and plan inventory needs to support warehouse operations and community food drives
- Coordinate incoming and outgoing shipments to ensure timely, accurate deliveries
- Manage inventory databases, tracking categories, expiration dates, and storage locations
- Use **CRM tools** to maintain and track relationships with vendors, donors, community partners, and transportation providers
- Monitor supply chain performance and prepare regular reports for leadership

- Knowledge of inventory management systems and supply chain software is an asset
- Strong understanding of food safety regulations and ethical sourcing practices
